


- TEMPLATE I PRINTED ONTO BLACK CARD

STEP 1: CUT OUT TEMPLATE 1




STEP 2: CUT OUT THE MIDDLE CIRCLE OF THE SHAPE

STEP 4: CUT OUT EYE FROM TEMPLATE 2




STEP 5: STICK EYE FACE DOWN ON THE BACK OF MAGNIFYING GLASS SHAPE




STEP 6: CUT OUT PLANK FROM TEMPLATE 3



STEP 7: STICK MAGNIFYING GLASS ON THE CEREAL BOX, AND CUT IT OUT




STEP 8: TAPE EDGE OF PLANK TO THE BACK OF MAGNIFYING GLASS




STEP 9: FOLD PLANK OVER MAGNIFYING GLASS








THE PARABLE OF THE LOST SHEEP MATTHEW 18:10-14 THIS CRAFT CAN ALSO BE USED TO TEACH

THE GOOD SHEPHERD OR PSALM 23



YOU WILL NEED:

- CEREAL BOX
- BLACK PAINT
- SPONGE/PAINTBRUSH
- PAPER PLATE FOR PAINT PALETTE
- WHITE WOOL
- PRINTED TEMPLATE ONTO PAPER
- SCISSORS
- FELT PEN



STEP 1: CUT OUT PRINTED TEMPLATE



STEP 2: LAY THE TEMPLATE ONTO CARDBOARD AND DRAW **AROUND IT**



STEP 3: CUT OUT THE SHAPE DRAWN ONTO THE CEREAL BOX



STEP 4: USE SMALL SCISSORS TO CUT A SLIT JUST BEFORE THE TAIL



STEP 5: USE SPONGE OR BRUSH TO PAINT THE SHEEP BLACK ON BOTH SIDES



STEP 6: CUT A PIECE OF WOOL APPROXIMATELY 50 CMS LONG AND TIE ONE END AROUND THE WHOLE BODY OF THE SHEEP



STEP 7: KEEP WRAPPING THE WOOL ALL OVER THE BODY OF THE SHEEP AS IF IT WERE A COTTON REEL



STEP 8: WHEN THE WOOL RUNS OUT, TUCK THE END INTO THE SLIT NEXT TO ITS TAIL

FOR A SHORTER SESSION STILL: PREPARE STEP 5
