LUKE 15:11-32

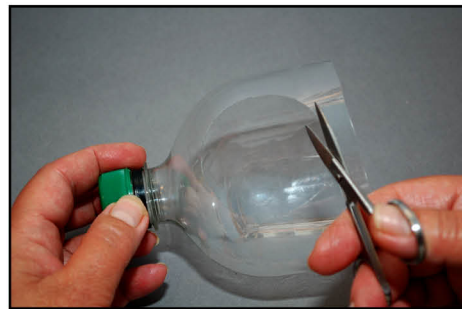


YOU WILL NEED:

- SPONGE



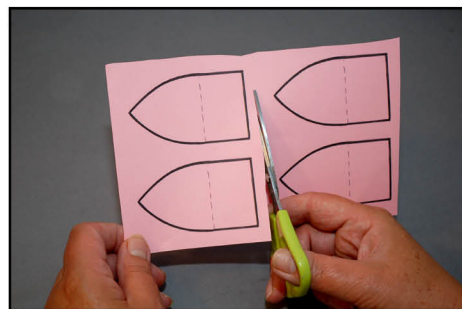
STEP 1: CUT HEAD OFF BOTTLE



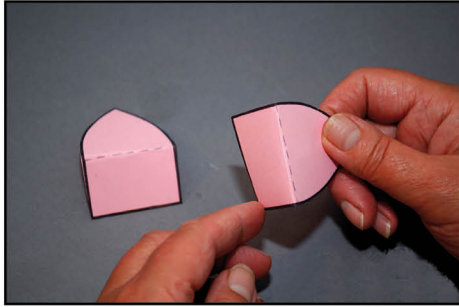
STEP 2: CUT HOLE INTO SIDE OF BOTTLE HEAD



STEP 3: GLUE PINK TISSUE PAPER OVER BOTTLE HEAD



STEP 4: CUT OUT TWO EARS FROM TEMPLATE



STEP 5: FOLD EARS ALONG DOTTED LINE



STEP 6: STICK EARS ONTO EACH SIDE OF THE BOTTLE HEAD



STEP 7: STICK EYES ON



STEP 8: CUT UP SPONGE



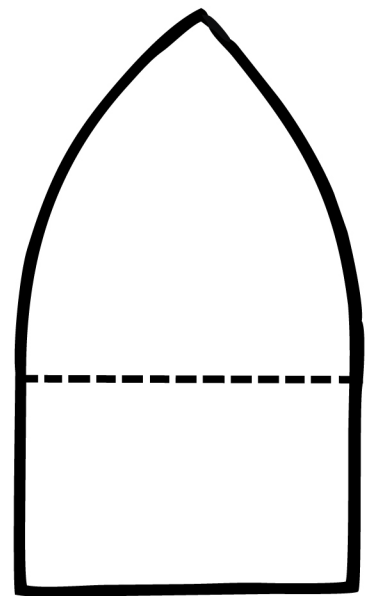
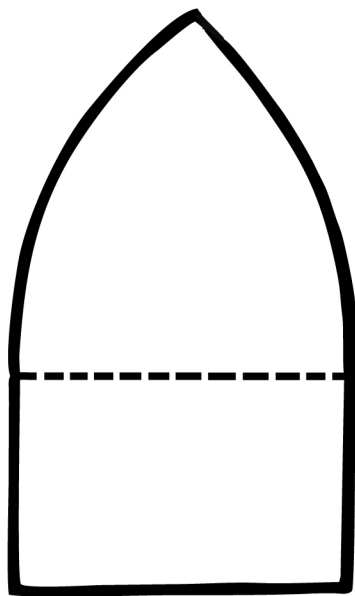
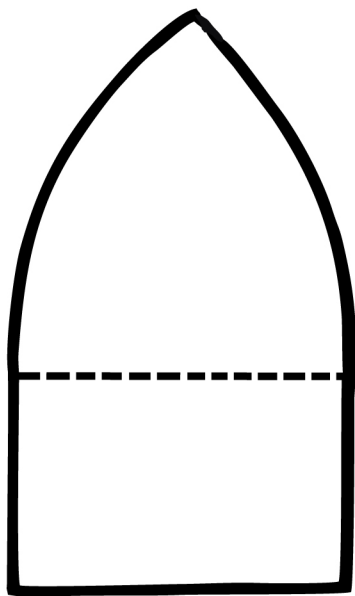
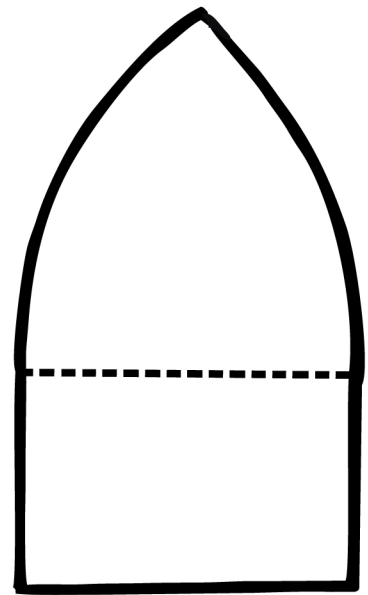
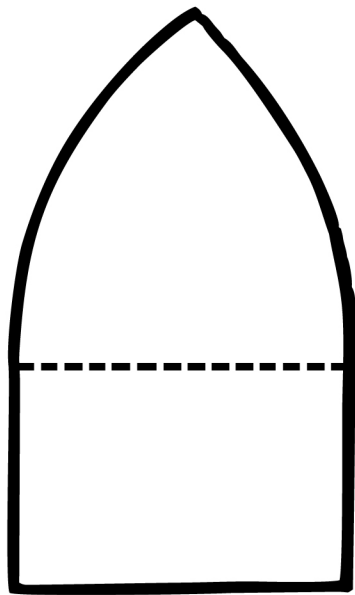
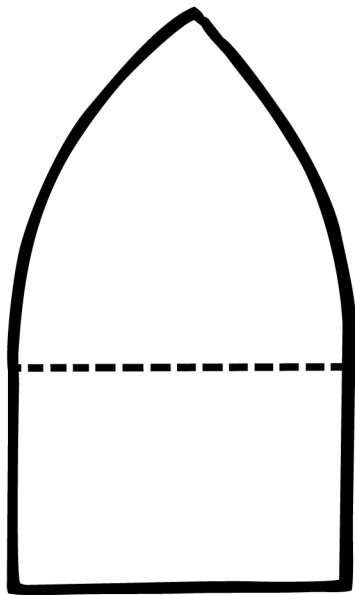
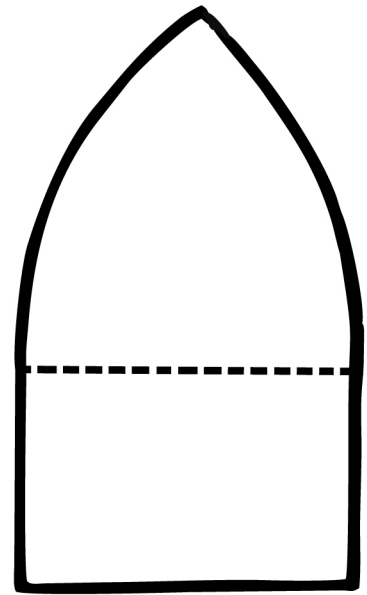
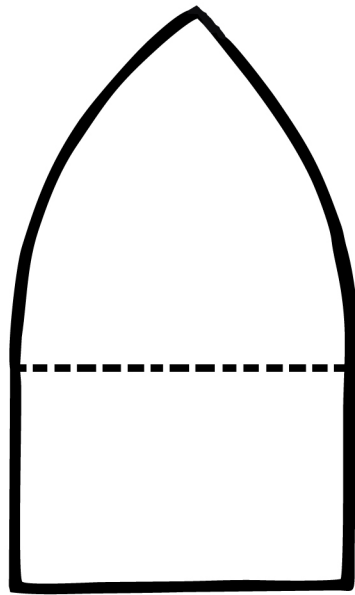
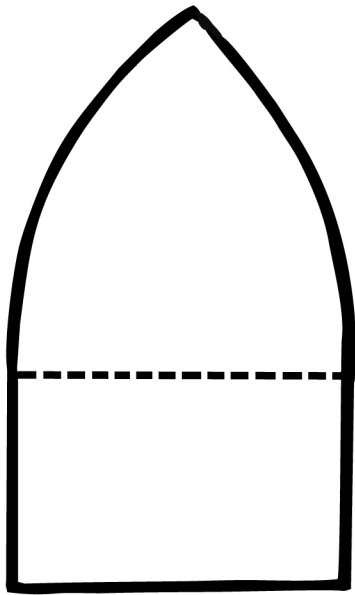
STEP 9: FINISHED! THE CHILDREN CAN PLAY THE GAME OF FEEDING THE PIG THE SPONGE

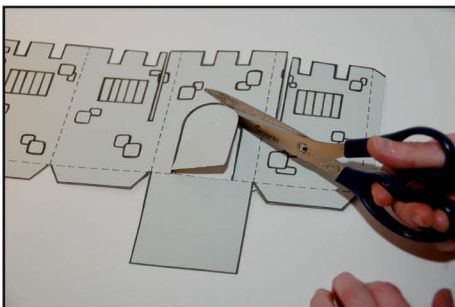
- TEMPLATE 1 PRINTED ONTO GREY CARD

- COLOURED PENCILS OR FELT TIPS



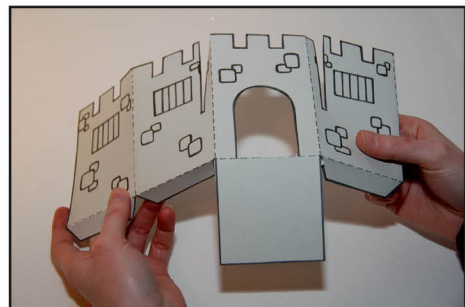
STEP 1: CUT OUT TEMPLATE 1



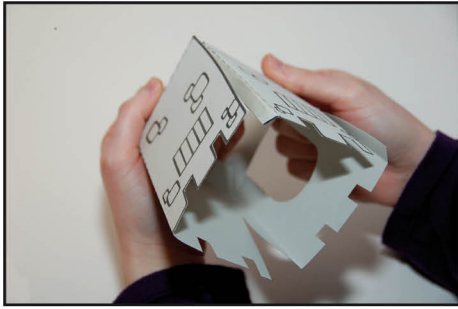
STEP 2: CUT DOWN THE TWO SLITS DOWN THE SIDES



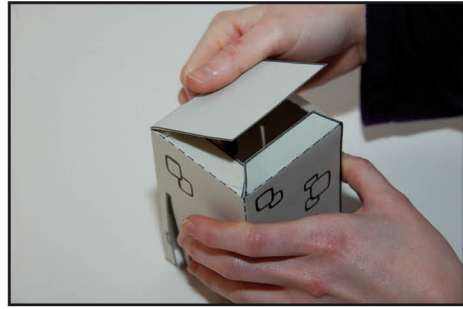
STEP 3: CUT OUT THE DOOR



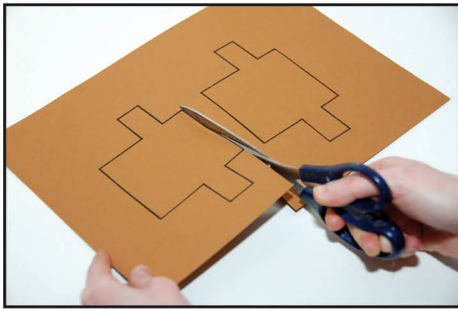
STEP 4: FOLD ALONG THE DOTTED LINES



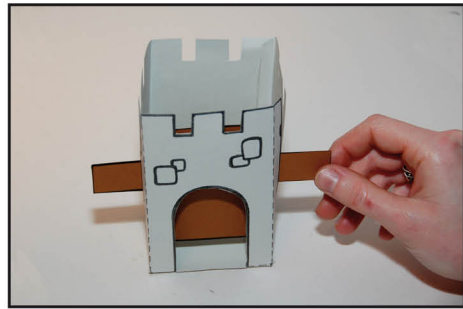
STEP 5: FOLD THE TEMPLATE ROUND AND STICK THE TAB ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE



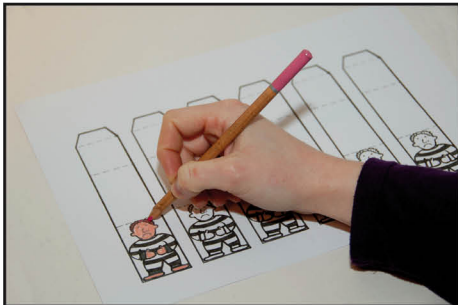
STEP 6: FOLD OVER THE BOTTOM FLAP AND STICK IT ON THE TABS



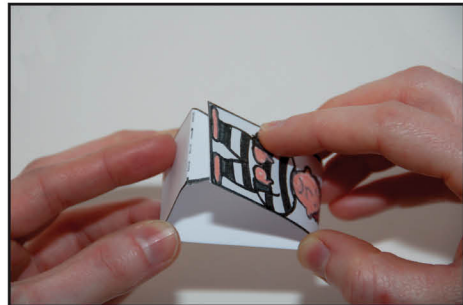
STEP 7: CUT OUT DOOR FROM TEMPLATE 2



STEP 8: SLOT DOWN DOOR WITH THE EDGES GOING THROUGH THE SLATS



STEP 9: COLOUR IN FIGURE ON TEMPLATE 3

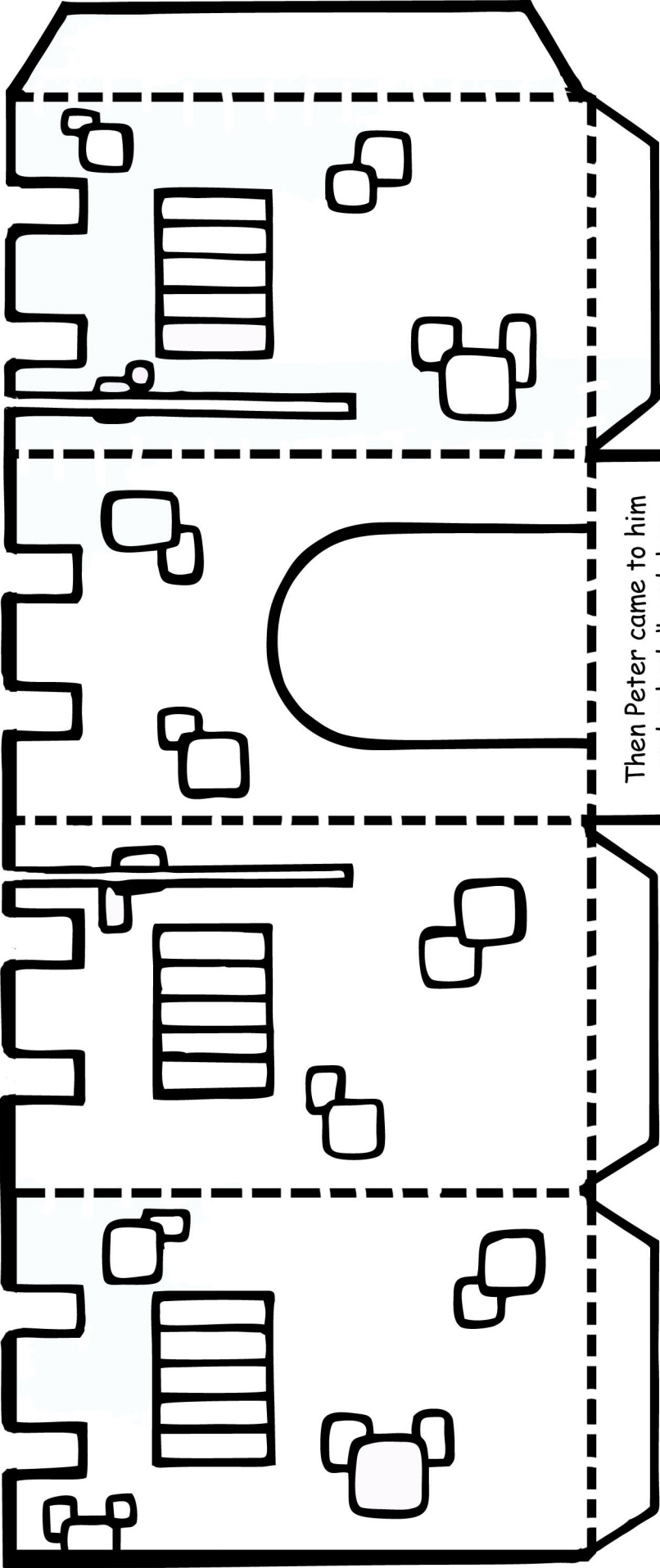


STEP 10: FOLD THE DOTTED LINES AND FOLD IT ROUND INTO A TRIANGLE, STICKING THE TAB TO THE OPPOSITE SIDE

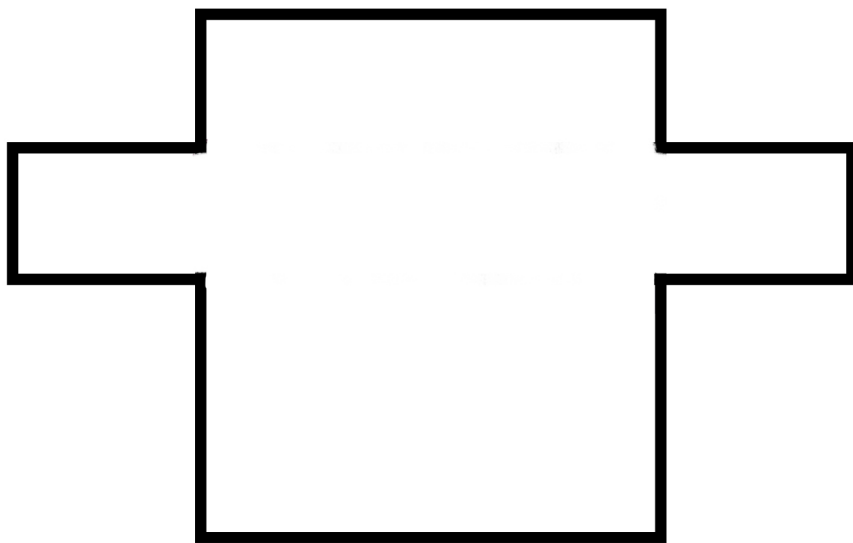
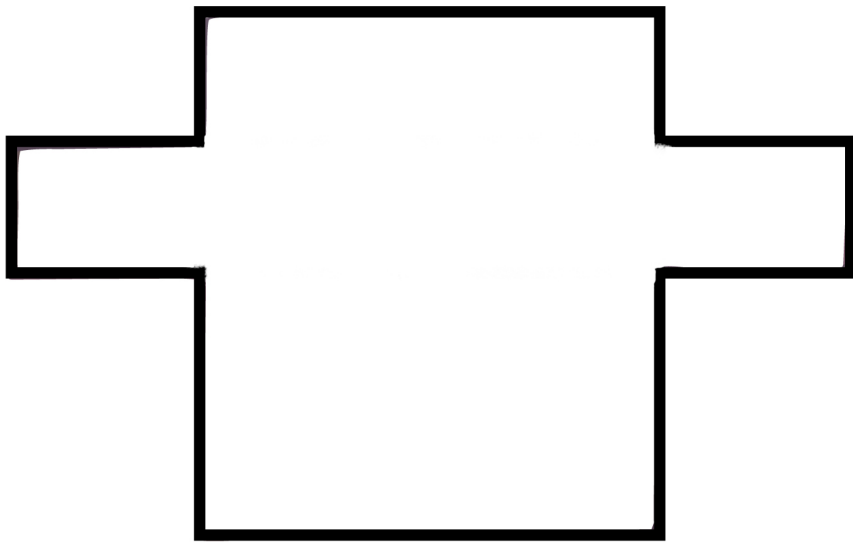
